## CONFERENCE OVERVIEW

The 2017 CORD+SDHS conference, hosted by The Ohio State University in Columbus, Ohio, marks a historic merger of these two important organizations into the Dance Studies Association (DSA). This inaugural conference of DSA is themed Transitions and Traces: Rendering Dance. It will celebrate the collaboration and cooperation that has led to combining our strengths as Dance Studies scholars to achieve DSA's aspirations to serve and grow its international membership. With this conference, CORD and SDHS seek to bring together scholars to address the questions of where dance scholarship sits in the broader arena of dance transmission, with considerations of how dance might be tracked or how it might be untraceable. We are further interested in how dance transmission interacts with educational and presentational practices, with efforts to document dance permeating the current legibility of dance as a cultural phenomenon. We look forward to a program that includes paper presentations, movement workshops, lecture demonstrations, screen dances, workshops, and roundtables.

We expect 250 to 300 scholars from around the world will gather at The Ohio State University to present research and explore the role of transmissions and traces in dance. This conference will offer an excellent venue to promote dance and performance publications to attendees.

### **CORD**

The Congress on Research in Dance (CORD) is an interdisciplinary organization with an international membership that promotes a globally inclusive and respectful dialogue around embodied and discursive approaches to dance research. CORD publishes the *Dance Research Journal (DRJ)*, a peer-reviewed scholarly journal three times a year in print and online.

### **SDHS**

The Society of Dance History Scholars (SDHS) advances the field of dance studies through research, publication, performance, and outreach to audiences across the arts, humanities, and social sciences. SDHS publishes new scholarship through its conference proceedings and book series and collaborates regularly with peer organizations. During each conference, SDHS working groups meet to share information and ideas. SDHS presents annual awards in recognition of outstanding scholarly work in dance studies at each conference, including the de la Torre Bueno Prize®.

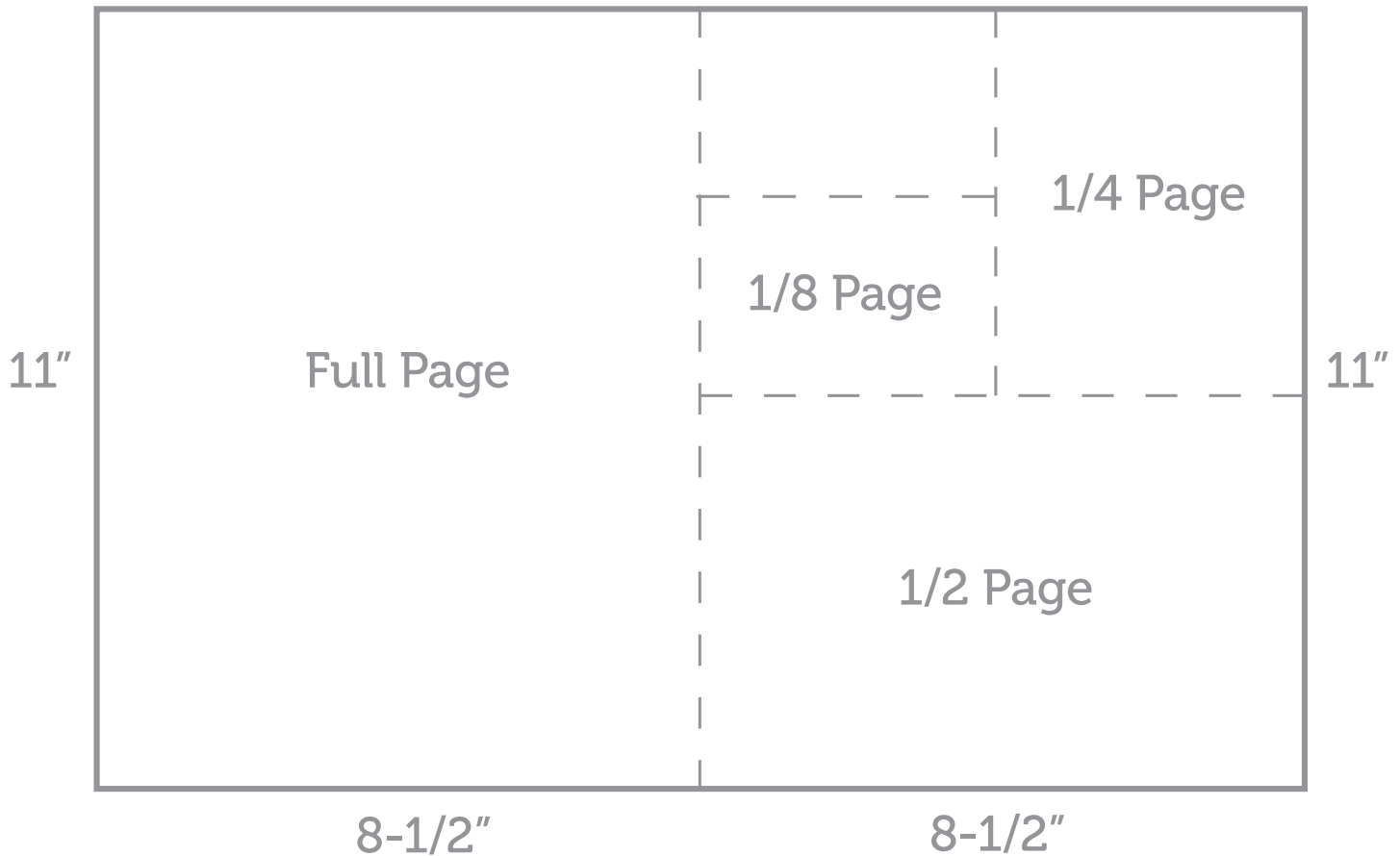
